

Honor Pin for Volunteers

The Honor Pin recognizes a volunteer's exemplary service in support of delivering the GSLE (Girl Scout Leadership Experience), which has had measurable impact on a geographic area of service, and helps the council reach and surpass its mission-delivery goals for that area.

Criteria: The nominee is an active, registered adult Girl Scout. The service performed by the nominee is above and beyond the expectations for the position held, and made an impact on two or more geographic areas within the council's jurisdiction.
