

Thanks Badge 2 for Volunteers

The Thanks Badge 2 is used to recognize an adult member who has already received the Thanks Badge and who has continued to provide exemplary service in a leadership role, resulting in a measurable impact that benefits the entire Girl Scout Movement.

Criteria: The nominee is an active, registered adult Girl Scout and a former recipient of the Thanks Badge. The Thanks Badge 2 honors continuous high-level Girl Scout service and may be awarded at least five years after a member earns Thanks Badge 1. The outstanding service performed by the nominee resulted in outcomes that benefited the total council, or entire Girl Scout organization, and is so significantly above and beyond the call of duty that no other award would be appropriate.

If form received by **March 1**, nominated recipient may receive the pin at the GSWNY Annual Meeting. For presentation at other venues, please submit at least eight weeks prior to proposed presentation date.
