- 🎈 **Sing Everywhere** - learn some Girl Scout songs or teach them to someone.

- 🎈 **Participate** in a troop meeting, service unit event, or a [council program](#).

- 🎈 **Girl Scout Traditions** – Recite the Girl Scout Promise and Laws, learn something about the history of Girl Scouting, or cook and eat a S'more.

- 🎈 **Girl Scout Swaps** – learn about them, make them, and share them.

- 🎈 **Live the Girl Scout Promise & Law** – do an activity that makes the world a better place, like collecting birthday party essentials like paper goods and cake mixes for your local food pantry.
