As you'll see, GSUSA and the GSWNY are planning many exciting events to reflect Girl Scouts as the voice of and for girls. At the same time, our council as well as those across the country, are planning local and statewide anniversary events and activities.

## “Leadership and Innovation...The Next 100 Years.”

The 52nd National Convention of Girl Scouts of the USA, to be held November 10-13, 2011 at the George R. Brown Convention Center in Houston, TX. The Girl Scout Leadership Institute (part of the National Convention) will also be in Houston on November 9-13, 2011. From ruling the world to space travel – past, present and future, 1,200 girls 13 and older will hear from world-renowned leaders and innovators and gain hands-on experience with cutting-edge technology and professionals. Opportunities to market themselves, track products through development and marketing, and connect with Girl Scouts from across the country will abound. ## Girl Scouts Forever Green

Through this nationwide community “take action” project, Girl Scouts will be at the forefront of environmental sustainability, leading schools and communities in conserving energy and protecting natural resources. Girl Scouts Forever Green is a series of month-long initiatives with lasting effects:

- Plastic waste reduction. Girls Scouts will be working to promote the use of reusable shopping bags and water bottles – to replace the 22 billion plastic water bottles and 100 billion plastic shopping bags America uses every year and the 60 million plastic water bottles we throw away every day. When: February, March or April.
- Rain garden construction. Girl Scouts across the US will create rain gardens to increase green space and wildlife habitat, and help prevent pollutants from leaching into streams. When: February, March or April.
- Saving energy. In March, Girl Scouts, friends, family and community affiliates will lead the switch to ENERGY STAR® lighting from incandescent bulbs. And on March 31st, Girl Scouts will join people in 135 countries in switching off all electric lights 8:30-9:30 p.m. in a symbolic Earth Hour stand against climate change



## 100th Anniversary Illustrated Book

Girl Scout Merchandise secured a national licensing agreement with publisher Stewart, Tabori & change (a division of Harry N. Abrams) for an illustrated book celebrating Girl Scouts’ 100th anniversary. The book, which is scheduled for publication in Fall 2011, will be available in book stores, other book-carrying retail venues, and Girl Scout council shops.

## Commemorative Girl Scout Merchandise

A line of 100th anniversary Girl Scout merchandise will be introduced in Fall 2011. Items will include T-shirts, messenger bags, and a collector’s series of patches and pins. Merchandise designed for girls will be contemporary and future-focused, and there will be a vintage-themed line for adults.

## Exhibits Promoting Girl Scout History

The rich history of Girl Scouting’s first 100 years will be showcased in traditional and innovative ways nationwide. GSUSA is in contact with museums and organizations with potential to serve as showcase partners. A “rig book”/ style guide will be shared with councils and history volunteers by Fall 2010 and will help guide the development of local displays and exhibits.

## How are registrations processed?

NEW! Online eBiz registration is now available and is the quickest and simplest way to register. You can also see real-time capacity for programs.

Registration is processed on a first come, first served basis. Online

registration and capacity update is real-time. For paper registration, registration forms are date stamped upon receipt at the council service center(s) and are processed in the order received. Orders are not accepted via telephone. In fairness to all, we do not hold spaces.

## Who can attend programs?

Programs are for registered Girl Scouts unless otherwise noted. Some events may include family or friends. All members who register for a program must be accompanied by their troop leader or by an adult if they register as individuals. Please indicate when registering the number of adults attending, even if there is no charge. Grade levels are specified in the program descriptions. If registering with the paper form, please note that the program may have closed prior to the form being received at the council office. We encourage online registration and computers are available at the council offices for members who do not have computer access at home.

## Can I bring a friend who is not a Girl Scout?

Friends are always welcome but we ask them to register as Girl Scouts. Registering as a Girl Scout has many benefits, including access to wonderful program opportunities and coverage under Girl Scout insurance when participating in programs. Girl Scout pathway programs offer flexible ways for girls to participate – camp, troop, series, events and travel. All programs listed in the program guide are ways for girls to participate as a Girl Scout. Non-scouts may register using eBiz once they Create a Profile. Please see the GirlScouts: eBiz-Online Membership Registration! page our website for full details on eBiz and how to log in.

## Are Try-its, badges or patches included in the fee?

If a Try-it, Badge or Patch is included in the fee, it will be stated that the fee includes badge and materials. If it is not listed in the description, girls and/or troops must purchase them on their own. Visit our Girl Scout shop(s) or purchase your items online at: <http://store.gswny.org>

## Is Financial Assistance Available?

Yes, financial assistance, if needed, is available for any program offered by the Council. Please allow for additional processing time when requesting financial assistance. Note; Registrations requesting financial assistance cannot be processed in eBiz.

## Do I need to follow safety guidelines?

Troop leaders are responsible for all health forms, parent permission slips, transportation, a First-aid kit, proper adult/girl ratio and behavior of girls and ensuring a First-Aider when needed as outlined in *Volunteer Essentials*. Safety standards and all requirements must be met or a troop will be turned away from the event without a refund.

## What is your refund policy?

Refunds will only be made if a girl is unable to be placed in a program or if the program is cancelled by the Girl Scout Council.

## What if a program is cancelled?

Participants will be notified of cancellations and any unforeseen changes beyond our control. If weather is questionable, please call your local Service Center for program status.
