| What will I need for this grant? | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An online account in order to fill out the application (see the guidelines updated regularly here). 2. Two letters of reference. 3. A girl who is working on a service project in the community. |
| Who should fill out this grant? | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The girl and one of her parents/guardians should fill out this application. • Applications submitted on the behalf of the girl or for a group of girls will not be eligible for the award. |
| What are the different parts of this grant? | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Online application: step-by-step process that guides the girl through the application. 2. Letters of reference: applicant must have at least two letters of reference, neither of which can be from a family member. Letters of reference should be from adults who have an important role in the girl's life and one needs to be from someone who oversaw the girl's project. |
| Dos and Don'ts for the Online Application | <p>DO: write good sized paragraphs (100-150 words) explaining (<u>from the girl's perspective</u>) why this project is important, the impact it had, why it was chosen, how it helped the community, etc.</p> <p>DON'T: write one or two sentences vaguely describing the project.</p> <p>Paste-able language:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • X is a cause important to me because...and that is why I would like to do this project to benefit X. • This project will (explain what project |

| | <p>will do). This is important to me and my community because...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I plan this project over (insert time period) by (explain plan) and determine it is successful by (explain evaluation). |
| <p>Dos and Don'ts for the Letters of Reference</p> | <p>DO: get one letter of reference from an adult who was/is involved first hand with the project, and another letter from a mentor in the girl's life.</p> <p>DON'T: get letters of reference from parents, grandparents, or adults who don't know the girl that well.</p> |
| <p>How do I submit this grant?</p> | <p>This grant is submitted online through the account you will make for the online application. Applications are not accepted any other way.</p> |
| <p>When are the deadlines for this grant?</p> | <p>April 15, annually</p> |
