Here are the Steps:

- 1. Complete two Senior or Ambassador Journeys OR earn the Silver Award and complete a Journey
- 2. Identify an issue
- 3. Investigate your issue thoroughly
- 4. Get helpand build your team
- 5. Create a plan
- 6. Present your plan and gather feedback
- 7. Take Action
- 8. Educate and inspire
