Can you write a letter to your neighbor, or fire department, post office etc. thanking them for all the hard work that do in the community. Can you draw a friendly picture using chalk in front of your neighbor sidewalk.





Below you can find more things you can do to be a good neighbor:

- Draw a thank you note for you garbage collector and tape it to your trash bin
- Leave a note or card for the postman
- Draw a picture and place in your window for neighbors to see
- Leave a friendly note or card on your neighbor porch
- Say hello or wave everytime you see your neighbor
