I Camped, I Conquered Guidelines:

- **Commit:** Commit to camping at all four camp properties.
- **Stay:** Your troop must spend at least one overnight at all of our council properties in either a lodge, platform tent, or camping tent.
- **Complete:** Complete at least one service project (listed below) and at least one additional item on the list for each camp.
- **Service Project Guidelines:** Leaders, please notify Karen Lundgard, Chief Outdoor and Property Officer, at karen.lundgard@gswny.org to let her know what service project your troop would like to do.
- **Beautify our spaces:** Perform deep cleans, pull weeds out of walkways, clean out firepits, rake under shelters, and restock wood piles.
- **Beautify our trails and fields:** Pick up large sticks from open fields so they aren't hit by the mower, clear debris from trails, and pull weeds from existing flowerbeds.
- **Submit & Purchase:** To purchase your property patches please bring this checked sheet into any of our council shops with the exact completion dates for each camp property. Lake patch does not have earning requirements. Patches are \$2 each.
