Junior Activity Choices

Walk your girls through the activity choices and let them decide which ones they would like to do in this meeting.

Think Like a Programmer Journey

Create Your Own Code

Juniors work in pairs to create their own code using symbols. This activity introduces programmers as people who create special codes for computers and the concept of different programming languages.

Think Like a Citizen Scientist Journey

Kim's Tray

Juniors practice observation and paying attention to the details as they try to remember a set of items. They will discover that it is helpful to document your observations and to think about what you see.

Think Like an Engineer Journey

Paper Structure

Juniors work in teams to design and build stable structures out of paper that can support the weight of several heavy books. Using the Design Thinking Process, girls brainstorm and design before they build and test their structures.

Outdoor Journey

Secure a Dunk Line

Juniors partner up and practice tying a clove hitch knot to tie a dunk line between two trees.

Junior Badge Year

Scavenger Hunt

Girls take part in a camping-themed scavenger hunt, then enjoy a s'mores snack.

Take the Stage

Juniors begin thinking about the different roles women and girls play in the world. They take turns acting out roles they play in life now, and those they may take on as they get older.
