Troop and Service Unit In-Person Event Safety Plan Checklist

Gathering size: Consult current gathering size maximum. For larger troops or service units,
consider staggering times to reduce size
Require all registrants to take their temperature and review screening questions prior to
attending. Members with fever or temperature higher than 100 should skip the in-person
gathering until their temperature is normal. Screening questions should be included in email
confirmation.
✓ Have you or anyone in your household (person(s) with whom you live) traveled either
domestically or internationally over the past two weeks? If yes, which location(s) did you
visit and which airports did you travel through? (Check the NYS website for quarantine
requirements for anyone who has recently traveled out of state)
✓ Have you or anyone with whom you live experienced any of the following symptoms within
the past two weeks?
✓ Have you or anyone with whom you live experienced any of the following symptoms over
the past 24 hours?
To your knowledge, have you been in close, sustained contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes
or more) with anyone showing any of the above-referenced symptoms, or anyone who has
been diagnosed with COVID-19 (Coronavirus)?
Social Distancing Plan for event location: attendees to programs must be provided with enough
room to physically distance themselves 6 feet apart
Post social distancing markers using tape or signs that denote 6 ft. of spacing in commonly used
and other applicable areas on the site
Attendees must be required to wear face masks when in attendance at all times. Additionally
disposable face coverings must be provided for those that do not have or cannot supply one
themselves
If applicable, create specific plan for girls to avoid sharing of supplies during program
(example: scissors, glue, sports equipment, utensils or any other commonly shared items)
