### Who Can Participate?

- Individual Girl Scouts in the same household
- Independently Registered Girl Scouts

A parent or caregiver must supervise at all times.

#### **Before You Start**

- 1. Have the Girl Scout's caregiver contact their Troop Cookie Manager to get cookies transferred to the Girl Scout.\*\*
- 2. Get location approval if you live in an apartment, gated community, or similar.
- 3. Always have an adult present- never leave cookies or money unattended.

## Important Details

- All Lemonade Stand sales are considered girl transactions. Payments taken in Digital Cookie should be under the Girl Scout's account as "Cookies in Hand."
- \*\*Girl Scouts are financially responsible for any cookies transferred to them for a Lemonade Stand.
  The amount due will be reflected in the Girl Balance Summary.
- Lemonade Stands cannot be held near retail stores, sporting events, or troop/council booths.
- · Keep cookies cool, shaded, and off the ground.
- Lemonade Stands may be held during GSWNY's Direct Sale dates.
- Lemonade Stands cannot be entered as a booth in Smart Cookies.
